Russia to hold 25th World Energy Congress in 2022

The announcement follows a vote by the Council's member countries in an excitingly contested campaign between Portugal, Russia and the USA. St Petersburg will become the site for the 25th World Energy Congress. **Dr Christoph Frei, Secretary General of the Council, commented**: "On behalf of the Council I want to congratulate Russia for winning the bid to host the 2022 Congress and thank all bidding countries for their excellent bids. The Portuguese, Russian and USA bid teams presented strong cases to host the event and it is clear that each of
