

The Council and Mexican government sign MOU to build joint talent in energy systems



In a ceremony held in Mexico City on 22 August, **Dr Christoph Frei, Secretary General of the World Energy Council** and **Pedro Joaquín Coldwell, Secretary of Energy**, signed a joint declaration to support capacity building and talent development through the roll out of a new government training scheme offered to exceptional Mexican candidates. The Memorandum of Understanding cements an agreement between the Council and Mexican government, to support capacity building of SENER's policy priorities specific to its energy systems, markets, and resources. It will include delivery of an in-depth exploration of Mexico's energy trilemma, consisting of three core dimensions: energy equity, energy security and environmental sustainability.
